This privacy policy applies to all personal data processed by Winchester College and its subsidiary companies, organisations, businesses and clubs. In this policy, these are all collectively called the "School". Winchester College is a charity, and our official name is the Warden and Scholars of St Mary College of Winchester and our registered charity number is 1139000. Our trading subsidiary, Winchester College Enterprises, is officially called Winchester College Trading Company Limited, Company number 02673873.

We may collect information about your approximate location when you submit a form on our website.

This may include:
